

3rd Annual LSAMP/AGEP Joint Research Conference at Indiana University

The Midwest Crossroads Alliance for Graduate Education and the Professoriate (AGEP) and Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP) – Indiana held their 3rd Annual LSAMP/AGEP Joint Research Conference November 8-10, 2007 at the Indiana University, Bloomington campus.

Attendance at the conference set a new record of 215, including 129 students – 91 undergraduates and 38 graduate students. Their fields of study included Biological Sciences (44%), Engineering (24%), Social Sciences (20%) and other majors (12%).

Participants were treated to a full program of speakers, workshops, research roundtables, oral and poster presentations, and facility tours. Workshop topics included: Graduate School Unplugged: What to expect?; Balancing life and Academia; Cultural Competency; Diversity Matters in the Classroom; Writing Personal Statements and CVs; Pros of Academia and Industry Careers; and many others. Tours included the Indiana University Cyclotron, the Media Visualization Lab, Simon Hall for Multidisciplinary Bioscience; and the Environmental Science Labs.
